

BY-LAWS

OF THE CORN CREEK COMMUNITY

ARTICLE I - NAME OF ORGANIZATION- CORN CREEK COMMUNITY

ARTICLE II - MEMBERSHIP

SECTION 1 - THE MEMBERSHIP OF THIS ORGANIZATION SHALL CONSIST OF ALL PERSONS WHO RESIDE IN THE CORN CREEK COMMUNITY FOR 30 CONSECUTIVE DAYS AND TO BE RECOGNIZED AT A REGULAR MEETING.

SECTION 2 - ONLY RST ENROLLED MEMBERS 18 YEARS OLD OR OLDER SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO CAST ONE VOTE ON COMMUNITY AFFAIRS DURING REGULAR OR SPECIAL MEETINGS OF THE COMMUNITY.

ARTICLE III - OFFICERS

SECTION 1 - OFFICERS OF THE CORN CREEK COMMUNITY SHALL CONSIST OF A CHAIRMAN; A VICE-CHAIRMAN; A SECRETARY; A TREASURER AND A SGT-AT-ARMS.

SECTION 2 - TO BE ELIGIBLE TO SERVE AS AS OFFICER OF THE CORN CREEK COMMUNITY A MEMBER MUST BE AN ENROLLED MEMBER OF THE ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE.

IN ADDITION, TO BE ELIGIBLE TO SERVE AS AN OFFICER OF THE CORN CREEK COMMUNITY, A MEMBER MUST RESIDE IN THE COMMUNITY FOR A PERIOD OF 30 DAYS CONSECUTIVELY PRIOR TO ELECTION TO OFFICE.

SECTION 3 - CHAIRMAN. THE CHAIRMAN SHALL HAVE THE POWER TO CALL REGULAR OR SPECIAL MEETINGS OF THE COMMUNITY AS PROVIDED HEREIN. COMMUNITY MEMBERS CAN REQUEST TO THE CHAIRMAN FOR A MEETING, CHAIRMAN WILL HAVE TO FOLLOW-UP UPON THE REQUEST. THE CHAIRMAN SHALL CONDUCT ALL MEETINGS AND SHALL SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS CONCERNING COMMUNITY MATTERS. THE CHAIRMAN SHALL REPRESENT THE COMMUNITY ON OTHER COMMITTEES AND BOARDS ARE REQUIRED.

SECTION 4 - VICE-CHAIRMAN. THE VICE-CHAIRMAN SHALL ASSUME THE RESPONSIBILITIES IN THE ABSENCE OF OR INCAPACITY OF THE CHAIRMAN.

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SECTION 5 - TREASURER. THE TREASURER SHALL KEEP ALL RECORD PERTAINING TO THE FINANCIAL MATTERS OF THE COMMUNITY. THE TREASURER SHALL SIGN ALL DOCUMENTS PERTAINING TO THE FINANCES OF THE COMMUNITY. THE TREASURER SHALL REPORT TO THE COMMUNITY ON MONTHLY BASIS, THE FINANCIAL STATUS OF THE COMMUNITY.

SECTION 6 - SECRETARY. THE SECRETARY AND TREASURER SHALL KEEP ALL RECORDS OF MINUTES AND FINANCIAL RECORDS OF THE CORN CREEK COMMUNITY.

SECTION 7 - ELECTION OF OFFICERS.

(SUB-SECTION 1)

ONLY MEMBERS WHO QUALIFY UNDER ARTICLE II, SECTION 2 AND WHO ARE ENROLLED MEMBERS OF THE ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE FOR OFFICERS OF THIS COMMUNITY.

(SUB-SECTION 2)

THE ELECTION SHALL TAKE PLACE IN NOVEMBER AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF OFFICE SET FORTH HEREIN.

SECTION 8 - TERM OF OFFICE. EACH OFFICERS TERM OF OFFICE SHALL BE TWO YEARS.

SECTION 9 - VACANCIES. SHOULD A VACANCY OCCUR AMONG THE OFFICERS, THE COMMUNITY MEMBERS SHALL ELECT NEW OFFICERS FOR THE VACATED POSITIONS.

SEC. 7, SUB-SECTION 1, ABOVE TO FILL OUT THE REMAINDER OF THE VACATING OFFICER'S TERM.

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SECTION 10 - REMOVAL OF OFFICERS. MEMBERS WISHING TO REMOVE AN OFFICER OR OFFICERS SHALL FOLLOW THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE.

- 1) A MOTION, IN WRITING, STATING THE REASONS FOR REMOVAL SHALL BE POSTED IN THE MANNER PROVIDED FOR POSTING OF A MEETING AT LEAST ONE WEEK PRIOR TO THE NEXT REGULAR MEETING.
- 2) AT THE NEXT REGULAR MEETING THE OFFICER WHO'S REMOVAL IS PROPOSED SHALL BE GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO APPEAR AND STATE HIS/HER CASE. A VOTE SHALL THEN BE TAKEN IN WHICH 2/3 MAJORITY VOTING IN FAVOR OF REMOVAL SHALL BE REQUIRED TO REMOVE THE OFFICER.

ARTICLE IV - QUORUM

10 VOTING MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY MUST BE PRESENT AT A MEETING FOR THAT MEETING TO TRANSACT BUSINESS.

ARTICLE V - MEETINGS

SECTION 1 - REGULAR MEETINGS. REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE COMMUNITY SHALL BE HELD THE SECOND WEDNESDAY OF EACH MONTH.

SECTION 2 - SPECIAL MEETINGS. SPECIAL MEETINGS MAY BE HELD AT THE REQUEST OF THE CHAIRMAN. THE VICE-CHAIRMAN MAY CALL A SPECIAL MEETING IF THE CHAIRMAN IS UNABLE TO AND GIVES HIS/HER CONCURRENCE.

SECTION 3 - NOTICE OF MEETINGS. NOTICE OF ANY MEETING WHETHER SPECIAL OR REGULAR SHALL BE MADE THREE (3) DAYS PRIOR TO SUCH A MEETING. NOTICE SHALL BE POSTED AT THE NORRIS POST OFFICE, THE PIONEER STORE AND THE GAS STATION AND STATION KINI. SUCH NOTICE SHALL STATE THE TIME, PLACE, AND AGENDA OF THE MEETING.

SECTION 4 - MEETINGS SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN AN ORDERLY FASHION. THE CHAIRMAN AND SGT-AT-ARMS SHALL BE EMPOWERED TO ENFORCE THE SECTION.

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SECTION 5 - ORDER OF BUSINESS

MEETINGS SHALL REGULARLY FOLLOW THIS ORDER:

- 1) INVOCATION
- 2) APPROVAL OF MINUTES
- 3) REPORTS FROM OFFICERS
- 4) REPORT FROM TRIBAL COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVE
- 5) REPORTS FROM COMMITTEES
- 6) OPEN COMMUNITY INPUT
- 7) OLD BUSINESS
- 8) NEW BUSINESS
- 9) ADJOURNMENT

SECTION 6 - RESOLUTIONS. RESOLUTIONS SHALL BE IN WRITING, SUBMITTED TO THE SECRETARY AT LEAST THREE (3) DAYS PRIOR TO THE REGULAR MEETING OR SPECIAL MEETINGS, AND POSTED AS SET FORTH IN SECTION 3 ABOVE.

ARTICLE VI - BUDGET

THE BUDGET OF THE COMMUNITY SHALL BE PRESENTED TO THE MEMBERSHIP AT LEAST MONTHLY FOR APPROVAL

ARTICLE VII - EXPENDITURES

SECTION 1 - THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE COMPOSED OF THE CHAIRMAN, VICE-CHAIRMAN, AND TREASURER SHALL BY MAJORITY VOTE AUTHORIZE EXPENDITURES FROM BUDGETED AMOUNTS TO PAY THE NECESSARY AND PROPER EXPENSES OF THE COMMUNITY. THE CHAIRMAN SHALL REPORT THE EXPENDITURES SO AUTHORIZED TO THE MEMBERSHIP AT EACH REGULAR MEETING.

SECTION 2 - THE CHAIRMAN AND THE TREASURER ARE HEREBY AUTHORIZED AS CHECK SIGNERS. BOTH OF THESE SIGNATURES MUST APPEAR ON EVERY CHECK AND/OR REQUISITION ON COMMUNITY FUNDS.

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ARTICLE VIII- COMMITTEES

SECTION 1 - HOUSING COMMITTEES. THE HOUSING COMMITTEE SHALL BE ELECTED BY THE COMMUNITY MEMBERS. THE COMMITTEE SHALL DISCUSS AND REPORT TO THE MEMBERS THE HOUSING AFFAIRS OF THE COMMUNITY.

SECTION 2 - THE COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES COMMITTEE.

ARTICLE IX - AMENDMENTS

AMENDMENTS TO THESE BY LAWS SHALL BE MADE BY A 1/2 VOTE IN FAVOR OF ANY SUCH AMENDMENTS AT ANY REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMUNITY.

RESOLUTION NO. 6966.

WHEREAS, presently there exists a situation which created by Sec. 1 of Article VI of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe which required that to qualify to vote in tribal election, the voter must be living in the community at least 90 days prior to the election day, and

WHEREAS, there are no voting districts established for each of the recognized communities listed under Sec. 2 of Article III of the Constitution and By Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe,

NOW THEREFORE, the Tribal Districting Committee of the Tribal Council moves the following Resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the boundaries of CORN CREEK community voting districts is hereby established to encompass the following described area:

Beginning in the SE corner of section 17, T41N, R31W, thence west along section line and north boundary of Black Pipe Com. Voting District to the Mellette County line, a approx. distance of 19 miles, thence northeasterly direction along the White River and Mellette Co. line to the SE corner of section 28, T45N, R31W, thence south along section line and county road through Cedar Butte to the point of beginning, a approx. distance of 22 miles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that adult members of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe living within the voting district are entitled to vote in the tribal or community election.

CERTIFICATION

We, the undersigned hereby certify that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is composed of 21 voting members of whom 17 members constituting a quorum were present at a duly called and convened session of the Tribal Council held August 26, 1969 at Rosebud, South Dakota, that the foregoing resolution was adopted by the affirmative vote of 12 members, 2 opposed, and 3 not voting.

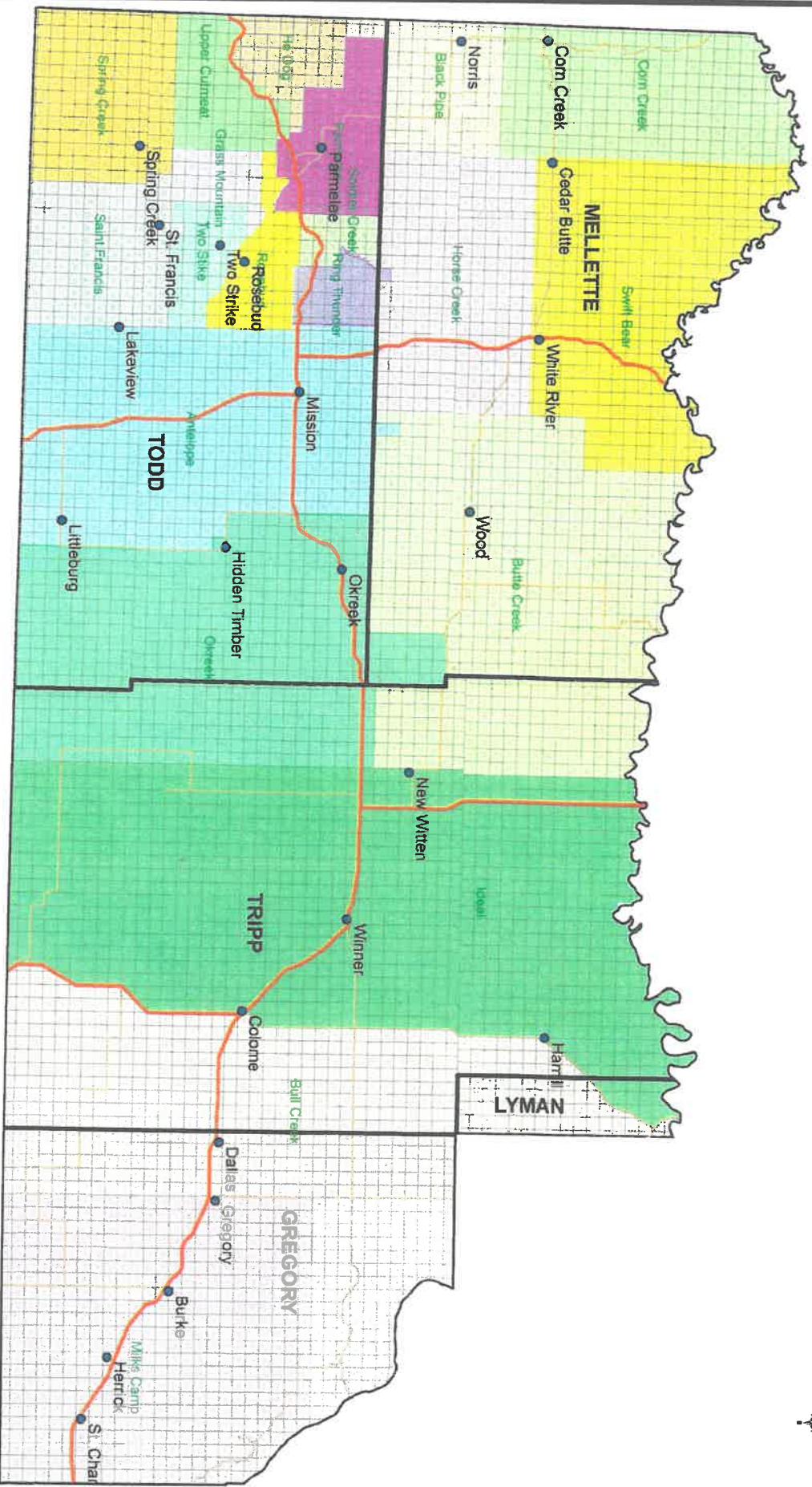

BY-LAWS

OF THE CORN CREEK COMMUNITY

ARTICLE I - NAME OF ORGANIZATION

The name of the organization shall be the Corn Creek Community

ARTICLE II - MEMBERSHIP

Section 1 *Applies to Doreen to Gardner* The membership of this organization shall consist of all persons who reside in the Corn Creek Community for 90 consecutive days. *DOREEN??*

Section 2 Only members 18 years or older shall be eligible to cast one vote on community affairs during regular or special meetings of the community ~~except as provided herein.~~ *CHANGED JUST TO ENROLLED MEMBERS OF THE R.S.T.*

ARTICLE III - OFFICERS

Section 1 Officers of the Corn Creek Community shall consist of a chairman; a vice-chairman; a secretary; a treasurer and a sgt-at-arms.

Section 2 *Applies to Alvin Battley* To be eligible to serve as an officer of the Corn Creek Community a member must be an enrolled member of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe. *A.R.B. NOT ENROLLED NOT 25 YRS*

In addition, to be eligible to serve as an officer of the Corn Creek Community, a member must reside in the Community for a period of 6 months consecutively prior to election to office.

Section 3 *125 MEMBERS* Chairman. The Chairman shall have the power to call regular or special meetings of the community as provided herein. The chairman shall conduct all meetings and shall sign all documents concerning community matters. The chairman shall represent the community on other committees and boards as required. *VICE CHAIRMAN*

Section 4 Vice-Chairman. The vice-chairman shall assume the responsibilities in the absence or incapacity of the chairman. *WHY WAS NO SPECIAL MEETING*

Section 5 Treasurer. The treasurer shall keep all records pertaining to financial matters of the community. The treasurer shall sign all documents pertaining to the finances of the community. The treasurer shall report to the community, on a monthly basis, the financial status of the community. *MARILYN WAS SUPPOSE TO BE AT THE HOSPITAL*

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Section 6 Secretary. The secretary shall record all minutes of meetings and keep records of the Corn Creek Community.

Section 7 Election of Officers.

(Sub-Section 1)

Only members who qualify under Article II, Section 2 and ~~who are enrolled members of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe shall be eligible to vote for officers of this Community.~~ ALVIN ??

(Sub-Section 2)

The election shall take place on the second Tuesday of November as required by the terms of office set forth herein.

Section 8 Term of Office. Each officers term of office shall be two years. 14R.

Section 9 Vacancies. Should a vacancy occur among the officers the remaining officers shall appoint a member who meets the requirements. Sec. 7, Sub-Section 1, above to fill out the remainder of the vacating officer's term. COMMUNITY

Section 10 Removal of Officers. Members wishing to remove an officer or officers shall follow the following procedure:

- 1) A motion, in writing, stating the reasons for removal shall be posted in the manner provided for posting of meeting at least one week prior to the next regular meeting.
- 2) At the next regular meeting the officer who's removal is proposed shall be given an opportunity to appear and state his/her case. A vote shall then be taken in which 2/3 majority voting in favor of removal shall be required to remove the officer.

ARTICLE IV - QUORUM

20 voting members of the Community must be present at a meeting for that meeting to transact business.

ARTICLE V - MEETINGS

Section 1 Regular meetings. Regular meetings of the Community shall be held the second Tuesday of each month
