
- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof and
- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and
- WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe's (RST) Tribal Historic Preservation Office (THPO) has entered in an Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) Cost Share Assistance contract with the USDA Natural Resource Conservation Service (NRCS) for land improvements on the Rosebud Sioux Tribe's PeSla Property located in the Black Hills, SD; and
- WHEREAS**, the RST Accounting Policies and Procedures requires us to follow the RST Procurement Policy to advertise in various news media a Request For Bids (RFB) to solicit contractors in compliance with Ordinance No. 2003-05; and
- WHEREAS**, the RST Tribal Historic Preservation Office (THPO) did the Request For Bids (RFB), Bid No. 19-030 for material and labor to install interior fencing for the PeSla Property. This bid was advertised twice in the media for two (2) weeks. The second advertisement received two (2) bids from SNS Fencing, LLC (\$86,793.80) with Indian Preference and Burkinshaw Fencing (\$42,547.20); and
- WHEREAS**, on June 17, 2019, the RST Land and Natural Committee at a regular scheduled meeting did review the two (2) bids and recommends awarding the bid to Burkinshaw Fencing; and
- WHEREAS**, the RST Tribal Historic Preservation Office (THPO) will utilize the cost-share assistance EQIP contract with NRCS to fulfill the costs for the total amount of this bid; now
- THEREFORE BE RESOLVED**, that the Tribal Council of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe accepts the recommendation from the RST Land and Natural Committee to award Bid No. 19-030 to Burkinshaw Fencing LLC in the amount of \$42,547.20 (NTE) and to enter into a Contract Agreement; now
- THEREFORE BE FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Tribal Council of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe hereby authorizes the Tribal President or his designee to sign any and all documents pertaining to this agreement.
