

**ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-66**

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and

WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is the grantee of the Sicangu Lakota Oyate Head Start/Early Head Start; and

WHEREAS, the SLO HS/EHS program requested sealed bids for replacing deck floors and hand rails at four Early Head Start centers from December 20, 2021 to December 31, 2021, January 10, 2022 to January 14, 2022 with an extended advertisement from January 24, 2022 to January 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the bid description stated to tear out floor/hand rails and replace with composite/trex to reinforce existing deck walkway for wheel chair accessibility at all four Early Head Start centers; and

WHEREAS, two sealed bids was received from C&C Custom Concrete at \$267,509.39 and LaCreek Development at \$202,958.25; and

WHEREAS, SLO HS/EHS is recommending approval for LaCreek Development at \$202,958.25; and


WHEREAS, this resolution was reviewed and passed by the RST Education Committee at a duly called meeting on Wednesday February 16, 2022 with a quorum present and has been recommended for to the RST Tribal Council; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council does hereby approve of LaCreek Development at \$202,958.25 to reinforce deck floors and replacing floor and handrails with trex at all four Early Head Start centers.
