

OKREEK COMMUNITY COUNCIL
Resolution 94-

WHEREAS, O'Kreek Community is a recognized Community under the Constitution and By-Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Article III - Governing Body, Section 2,; and

WHEREAS, the O'Kreek Community as a recognized governing body must operate under an established Community Constitution and By-Laws of the O'Kreek Community; and

WHEREAS, the O'Kreek Community does not have on record with the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Secretary' Office an adopted Community Constitution and By-Laws; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the O'Kreek Community Council Does hereby adopt the Constitution and By-Laws of the Okreek Community as follows:

CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF THE O'KREEK COMMUNITY

PREAMBLE

We, the adult members of the O'Kreek Community of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe, Rosebud Reservation, in order to establish a responsible and representative community organization, to promote the common welfare, to secure the blessing of liberty to ourselves and our posterity, to provide for our economic and social betterment through cooperative effort, to promote security, do ordain and establish this Constitution and By-Laws for the people of the O'Kreek Community.

ARTICLE I

NAME

Sec. I This organization shall be known as the O'Kreek Community of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe.

ARTICLE II

GOVERNING BODY

Sec. I The Governing Body of the Community Council shall be the Community Council.

Sec. II The governing body of the Community Council shall consist of the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and Sergeant-at-Arms.

Sec. III Any Rosebud Sioux Tribal member that lives within the geographical boundaries of O'Kreek Community shall be a member of the Community Council.

Sec. IV Non-members of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe may become members of this Community Council provided they reside in O'Kreek Community for a period of Ninety (90) days and they are officially adopted as a member of the Community Council by a majority vote at a regular scheduled meeting of the Community Council. Rosebud Sioux Tribal members who wish to become members of the Community Council must have resided in the boundaries of O'Kreek Community for a period of thirty (30) days and be accepted into the Community by a majority vote at a regularly scheduled meeting.

Sec. V The Community Council shall have the power to appoint any and all committees it deems necessary for the best interest of the Community and its growth.

Sec. VI It shall be the duty of the said community members to elect the community officers for a term of one year. Elections will be held in the month of August. The present term of the governing body shall expire at the conclusion of the election meeting.

ARTICLE III

QUORUM

Sec. I A quorum of eight (8) community members shall constitute business matters.

Sec. II It shall be the duty of the Secretary to record all names present at each meeting and record minutes.

Sec. III It shall be the duty of the treasurer to receive and deposit all monies of the O'Kreek Community in the Norwest Bank of Mission, South Dakota. All disbursements shall be paid by checks only. All checks will and shall be signed by the chairman and treasurer.

ARTICLE IV.

MEMBERSHIP

Sec. I A list of Membership and a complete Census shall be completed during every tribal election year. This Community Census shall be handled by an appointed committee and it must be completed by May 31st.

ARTICLE V.

MEETING DATE

- Sec. I It shall be the duty of the Community Chairman to call a regular meeting on the second Tuesday of each month.
- Sec. II It shall be the duty of the Community Chairman to call emergency meetings when he feels it is warranted. All emergency meetings shall have a minimum of three (3) days notice.
- Sec. III It shall be the duty of the Community Chairman to
- Sec. IV It shall be the duty of the elected District Representative to provide a full report of all Tribal Council activities pertaining to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe constituents and District II. This report shall be provided at the regular meeting to be held on the second Tuesday of each month.

ARTICLE VI.

VIOLATING OF OFFICERS

- Sec. I Each officer should notify the Community Council by written notice stating his or her reason for being absent.

ARTICLE VII.

RESOLUTIONS

- Sec. I Any and all resolutions shall be in a written form and signed by Chairman and attested by the Community Secretary.
- Sec. II All resolutions rejected by the Tribal Council shall be returned to the community for review and possible amendment.

ARTICLE VIII.

CERTIFICATION

- Sec. I The Chairman and the Secretary of the Community Council shall certify all proceedings and documents of this Community Council.

ARTICLE XI.

ORDINANCES

Sec. I The O'Kreek Community shall be empowered to pass Community Ordinances by and with the consent of the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council. These ordinances must be approved by a majority vote of the members present at two consecutive monthly meetings. The ordinances making power of the Community shall be subject to the overall supremacy of the Rosebud-Sioux Tribal Council.

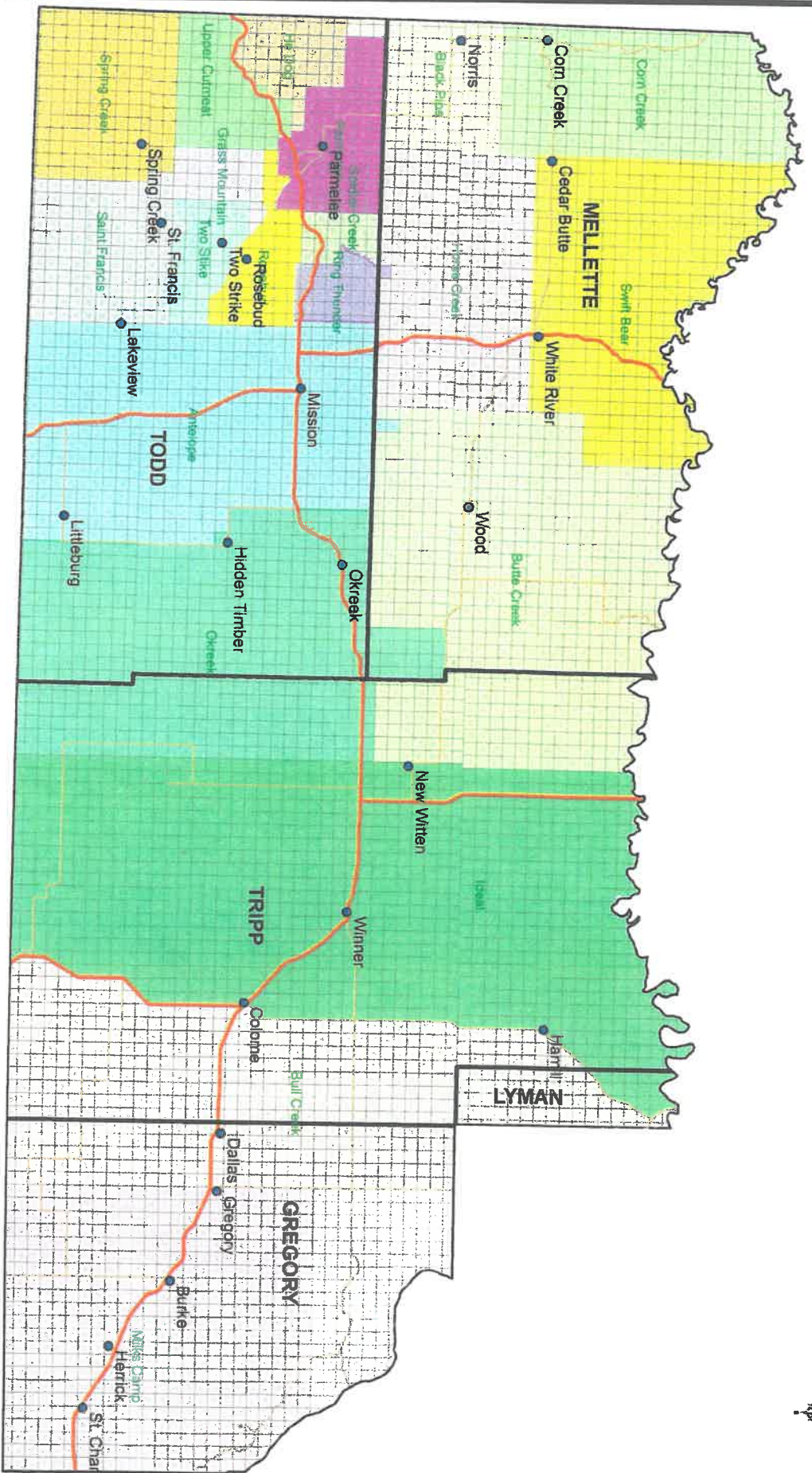
