

**ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE  
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-142**

**WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and

**WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and

**WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council having met on May 11, 2022, did approve the 2022 Fall Community Cleanup in the amount of \$196,706.40; and

**WHEREAS**, the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is approving a three-way split between TLE, SWA and the Rosebud Sioux Tribe in the amount of \$65,568.80, each totaling \$196,706.40 for the 2022 Community Fall Clean up; now

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council approves the 2022 Fall Community Clean Up and authorizes the Treasurer to sign any and all documents pertaining to this action.


**C E R T I F I C A T I O N**
