- WHEREAS, the Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance is seeking applications for the 2020 Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding Program Solicitation (CFDA # 16.034) from eligible entities with a due date of May 29, 2020 and
- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe has been deemed eligible to apply for funds totaling \$215,043 allocated to the Tribe for the purpose of assisting in preventing, preparing for, and responding to the coronavirus; and
- WHEREAS, Funds awarded under the Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding (CESF) Program must be utilized to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus. Allowable projects and purchases include, but are not limited to, overtime, equipment (including law enforcement and medical personal protective equipment), hiring, supplies (such as gloves, masks, sanitizer), training, travel expenses (particularly related to the distribution of resources to the most impacted areas), and addressing the medical needs of inmates in state, local, and tribal prisons, jails, and detention centers; and
- WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribe Law Enforcement Services Program (RSTLES) will be the lead implementing agency of funding awarded to the Tribe under the CESF Program to assist with the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Coronavirus Prevention, Preparation and Response efforts on the Rosebud Reservation; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council authorizes Sicangu Resource Development to submit an application in the amount of \$215,043 to the Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance for the 2020 Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding Program for the purpose of implementing Coronavirus Prevention, Preparation and Response efforts on the Rosebud Reservation by the deadline of May 29, 2020; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairman or official designee to sign all pertinent applications, contracts and documents thereof.
