

**TWO STRIKE COMMUNITY
BY-LAWS**

ARTICLE I

NAME

SEC. I This organization shall be known as the TWO STRIKE COMMUNITY of Rosebud, South Dakota.

SEC. II The members of this council shall consist of all members that live within the community of TWO STRIKE.

ARTICLE II

GOVERNING BODY

SEC. I Beginning of the first month of each year, it shall be the duty of the TWO STRIKE Community members to elect the community officers for a term of one year.

SEC. II The Community members shall have the power to make changes or fulfill any vacancies that may occur in the community or shall fulfill any vacancy in the Representative of the Tribal Council.

ARTICLE III

MEETING DATES

SEC. 1 It shall be the duty of the Community Chairman to call a regular meeting on the first Tuesday of every month.

SEC. II It shall be the duty of the Community Chairman to call a Special meeting at any time during the month.

ARTICLE IV

INVOCATION

SEC. I It shall be the duty of the Chairman at each Community meeting to call on one member to give an invocation before the meeting proceeds.

ARTICLE V

QUORUM

- SEC. I. A quorum of EIGHT members shall constitute business matters, including the Chairman.

ARTICLE VI

ROLL CALL

- SEC. I. It shall be the duty of the Community Secretary to make the roll call at each meeting, or get the number of members present for the meeting.

ARTICLE VII

POWERS

- SEC. I. The Council shall exercise the following powers.
- SEC. II To recommend resolutions and undertake and manage the Community enterprise for the benefit of the members of the community.
- SEC. III To get funds by collective and assessing or accept gifts and donations, or from any other sources, for defraying expenses for the organization.

ARTICLE VIII

REPORTS

- SEC. 1 It shall be duty of the Councilman to make monthly reports at each Community meetings.
- SEC. 11 It shall be the duty of the Community Treasurer to report its Community Funds,
- SEC. 111 II shall be the duty of the Community Treasurer to take up the collection for the Community Treasury.

ARTICLE IX

FLOOR

- SEC. I The Chairman shall call for open floor for unfinished business or for new business.

ARTICLE X

AMENDMENTS

SEC. I. The community council body may amend, approve or disapprove the Foregoing BY-LAWS.

ARTICLE XI

RESOLUTIONS

SEC. 1 Any and all resolutions will be in a written form and signed by the proper authority.

SEC. 11 All resolutions subject to renewed and approved by the Tribal Council.

ARTICLE XII

CERTIFICATIONS

SEC. I The Chairman and the Secretary shall certify all proceedings and documents of the council.

ARTICLE III

DUTIES OF THE OFFICERS

SEC. I **PRESIDENT:** The community Chairman shall preside at all meetings, preserve order and enforce By-Laws, or regulations thereof, and also he/she shall be entitled to a vote in case it is equally divided.

SEC. II **VICE-PRESDEPT:** Shall preside in the absence of the Chairman. When he/she be called upon to do so. He/she shall have all the rights and privileges and duties as well as responsibilities of the Chairman.

SEC. III **SECRETARY:** The Secretary shall keep all records, minutes of all proceedings and meetings. And perform any other special duty when called upon to do so.

SEC. IV **TREASURER:** The Treasurer shall be the custodian of all funds, or property which corned under his or her jurisdiction, he or she shall keep all records of funds and all expenditures made and be in position to submit a report at anytime. He or she shall take all disbursement subject to the order of the Chairman by authority by the council.

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SEC. V. SERGEANT AT ARMS: The Sergeant at Arms shall have authority to act as a Police and keep order at all meetings, and to secure and make proper arrangements for a meeting place.

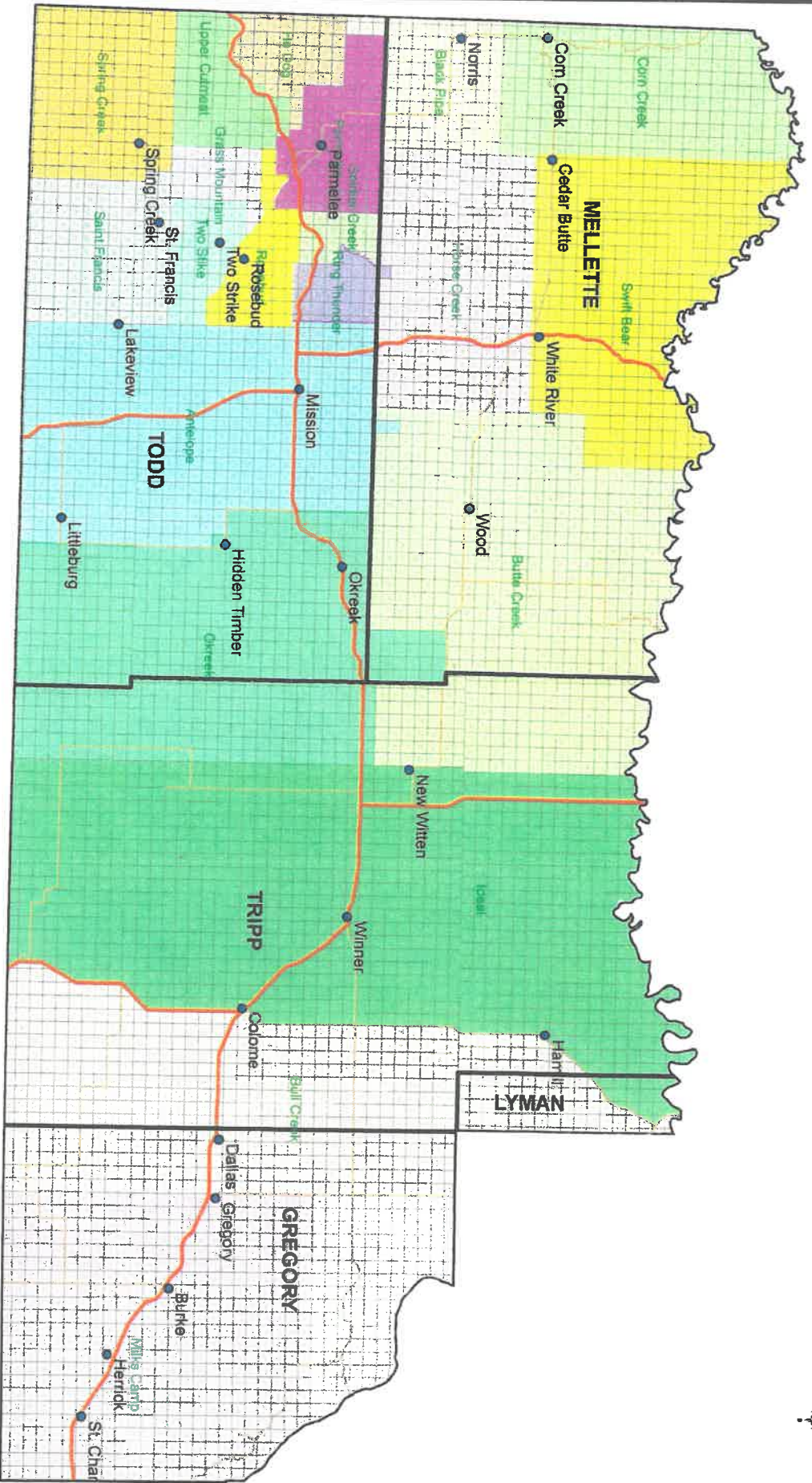
CERTIFICATION

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- SEC.11 The Community members shall have the power to make changes or fulfill any vacancies that may occur in the community or shall fulfill any vacancy in the Representative of the Tribal Council.
- SEC.111 Any person convicted of any felony or anyone who has been convicted under the guidelines of the Indian Child Protection Act or Family Violence prevention act shall not serve as an Officer of the Two Strike Community nor represent the Two Strike Community in any capacity in any public or private forum.

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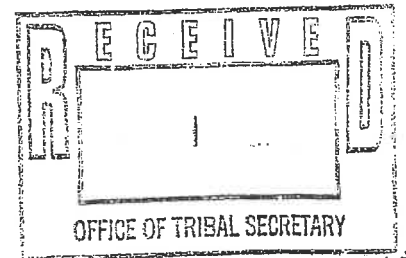

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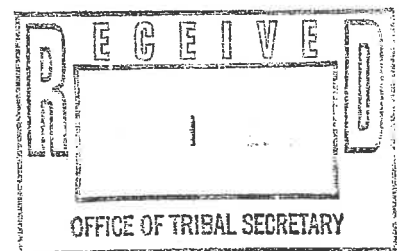
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
