ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE Resolution No. 2021-81

- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and
- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and
- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is authorized to promulgate and enforce ordinances for the maintenance of law and order, and to safeguard the peace and morals, and general welfare of the Tribe, pursuant to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Constitution and By-Laws, Article IV Sections 1(k), and (m); and
- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe has established the Tribal Judiciary Committee pursuant to the RST Ordinance No. 80-07, to operate with input from the directors of tribal programs and Tribal Council members to develop and coordinate all aspects of tribal budget activities in accordance with the Rosebud Sioux Tribe's Constitution and By-Laws; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Judiciary Committee has the authority and responsibility to review and recommend to Tribal Council approval of plans and projects initiated for the benefit of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe; and
- WHEREAS, the following US Department of Justice Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation (CTAS) grant purpose areas will enhance the public safety, victim services and youth services and perpetrator accountability within the exterior boundaries of the Rosebud Sioux Reservation;

Purpose Area # 8: Juvenile Tribal Healing to Wellness Courts (OJJDP), CFDA #16.585 will be administered by the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Children's Court. The project will be a 5 year project with an award amount up to \$400,000. If awarded, the grant will be used to enhance and expand the existing RST Juvenile Healing to Wellness Court

Purpose Area #9: Tribal Youth Program (OJJDP), CFDA #16.731 will be Administered by the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Sicangu Youth Program (SYP). The project will be a 5 year project with an award up to \$500,000. If awarded, the grant will be used to fund the Sicangu H.O.P.E (Healing, Opportunity, Prevention, Education) Teen Center for youth ages 13-17; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council approves and adopts this resolution and authorizes Sicangu Resource Development to submit the application **due on April 30, 2021**; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Tribal President or the designated official to sign and execute all applications and all documents thereof.
