- WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and
- WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and
- WHEREAS,** in accordance with Article VIII, Section 5 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe "Grant of Exchange Assignment of Tribal Land" can be reassigned to an eligible heir; and
- WHEREAS,** 345U10728, Audrey Louise Emery/Cordry, (DOD 3/5/2019) has Tribal Exchange Assignment #464-A, described a SE¼ of Section 26, Township 39N., Range 29W., 6th P.M., Todd County, South Dakota, containing 160 acres more or less; and
- WHEREAS,** pursuant to provisions of Section 2 of the "Grant of Exchange Assignment of Tribal Land" a Designation of Beneficiary is on file for Tribal Exchange Assignment #464-A, completed by 345U10728, Audrey Louise Emery/Cordry requesting that upon her demise this Tribal Exchange Assignment be reassigned to her son 345U18583, James Aubrey Cordry; and
- WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribe, Land & Natural Resources Committee has reviewed this request for reassignment and recommends approval by the Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council approves of the reassignment of Tribal Exchange Assignment #464-A to 345U18583, James Aubrey Cordry; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this reassignment be designated as Tribal Exchange Assignment #464-B; and

Grant of Exchange Assignment of Tribal Land

ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE OF THE ROSEBUD INDIAN RESERVATION, SOUTH DAKOTA

The Rosebud Sioux Tribe, a Tribe duly organized under a constitution and by-laws by the Secretary of the Interior on December 20, 1935, under authority of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984), hereby grants, according to the terms of Article VIII of the said constitution, to RSU-18583, James Aubrey Cordry a member of the said Tribe, assignee herein, an Exchange Assignment of the following described real property SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 39N., Range 26W., 6th P.M., Todd County, South Dakota, containing 160 acres more or less

Designation of Beneficiary RSU-10728, Audrey Louise Emery/Cordry of the following described real property: SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 39N., Range 26W., 6th P.M., Todd County, South Dakota containing 160 acres more or less

to the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA IN TRUST FOR THE ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE, executed on _____, 19__

This Exchange Assignment shall be held subject to the following conditions:

1. The land herein assigned may be used by the assignee or leased by him to Indian Cooperative Associations, to individual members of the Tribe, or, if no individual Indian or Indian Cooperative Association is able or willing to rent the land at a reasonable fee, to non-Indians, in the same manner as allotted land provided that leases to non-Indians do not interfere with the Reservation Land Use Program.

2. Upon the death of the assignee the land herein assigned shall be reassigned by the Tribal Council to such person as may be designated by the assignee, on the form attached hereto and made a part of the Exchange Assignment. If no designation is made, then to his heirs, determined in accordance with ordinances of the Tribal Council, subject to the following with the Constitution of the Tribe.

This land may not be reassigned to any heir or devisee who is not a member of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe, except that a life assignment may be made to the surviving widower, widow, or child of the holder of the assignment.

The land may not be reassigned to any heir or devisee who already holds more than ¹⁹²⁰ Acres of grazing land, or other land or interests in land of equal value, either under allotment or under assignment. If this acreage is found insufficient, it may be increased by the Tribal Council.

This land may not be subdivided among heirs or devisees into units too small for convenient management. No area of grazing land shall be subdivided into units smaller than 160 acres, no area of farm lands shall be divided into units smaller than 40 acres and no area of irrigated land shall be subdivided into units smaller than two and one-half acres, except that land used for buildings or other improvements may be divided to suit the convenience of the parties. Where it is impossible to divide the land properly among the eligible heirs or devisees, the Tribal Council shall issue to such heirs or devisees, grazing permits or other interests in Tribal lands of the same value as the assignment of the decedent.

If there are no eligible heirs or devisees of the decedent, the land shall be eligible for reassignment in accordance with the provisions of Article VIII, Section 4 of the Constitution of the Tribe.

3. Improvements of any character made upon this land may be bequeathed to and inherited to members of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe. No permanent improvements shall be removed without the consent of the Tribal Council.


4. This assignment, and the rights granted hereunder, may not be sold, but may be exchanged for another assignment in such manner as the Tribal Council may designate. This assignment may be surrendered at any time to the Tribe, by agreement of the assignee and the Tribal Council, in exchange for a money payment or a new assignment, either to the present assignee or to a relative or dependent whom he may designate, or for shares in Tribal Corporate lands, provided such person or persons is or are members of the Tribe.

5. All Timber, water rights, and mineral rights, and the right to take easements on the land for public purposes are reserved to the Tribe, but grants of rights of way will be in accordance with regulations of the Department of the Interior and the laws pertaining thereto. The assignee may cut and remove timber for domestic uses only.

6. This Exchange Assignment shall become effective immediately upon the execution of a deed of conveyance by the Assignee in favor of the Tribe covering his allotted land or inherited interests, subject to approval and acceptance of the deed by the Secretary of the Interior; and thereupon, this Exchange assignment shall vest in the assignee the exclusive right of use and occupancy of the lands covered by the assignment during his lifetime, and shall not be subject to change or cancellation by the Tribal Council or the Commissioner of Indian Affairs without the consent of the assignee. All exchange assignments shall be approved by the Tribal Council and the Superintendent of the Rosebud Indian Agency.

7. If unrestricted land is conveyed to the Tribe, it will be required of the Assignee to furnish clear title at his own expense to the land being conveyed. When this has been done, the Exchange Assignment shall thereupon become effective as above indicated under Section 6.
