- WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and pertinent amendments thereof: and
- WHEREAS, The Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-laws; and
- WHEREAS. The Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council is authorized to promulgate and enforce ordinances for the maintenance of law and order, and to safeguard the peace and morals, and general welfare of the Tribe, and to provide for the administration of justice, pursuant to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe Constitution and By-Laws Article IV Sections 1 (a),(k), and (m), and
- WHEREAS. The Rosebud Sioux Tribal Council enacted RST Resolution No. 2020-75, affirming the declaration of the President of the Rosebud Sioux Tribe that on March 13, 2020, a State of Emergency exists within the Tribe as it relates to the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), said declaration was made after the World Health Organization (WHO) declared on March 11, 2020 that the imminent threat to public health and safety from the spread of COVID-19 was a global pandemic; and
- WHEREAS. The Rosebud Sioux Tribe has authorized a corporate charter for Sicangu Wicoti Awayankapi (SWA) Corporation as its designated housing entity for purposes of operating housing and receiving and administering federal and other grant funds; and
- The Rosebud Sioux Tribe passed a motion on September 10, 2020, directing SWA to work on WHEREAS. the construction of homes for the shelter of homeless, with ten (10) tiny homes ordered and ready for occupancy by December, 2020; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Rosebud Sioux Tribe requests an immediate report from SWA on the progress of the project for the construction of ten (10) tiny homes and whether they will be ready by December, 2020; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that SWA provide its report on the tiny homes project at the next regularly scheduled meeting.
