


**ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE
RESOLUTION NO. 2022-72**

- WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and
- WHEREAS,** the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and
- WHEREAS,** Article V of the RST Constitution grants communities authority to make recommendations to the Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** the Okreek Community recommends that the Tribal Council and Administration allow communities the opportunity in the decision on whether to have one centralized youth center; and
- WHEREAS,** the Okreek Community recommends Tribal Council or CARES Act/ARPA Committee reconsider and rescind any prior actions pertaining to a centralized youth center until such time as all communities have had the opportunity to provide input; and
- WHEREAS,** the Okreek Community has concerns on the transportation, bullying of our youth if the tribe provides transportation and the distance of time travel for many of our youth; and
- WHEREAS,** the Okreek Community recommends the Tribal Council, CARES Act/ARPA committee develop a plan to allow each individual community the opportunity to develop a plan for a youth center or a structure for the youth within their respective community with the approval of the Tribal Council; now
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** the Okreek Community directs its council representative to present and support Okreek Community Resolution No. 2022-01 and request a roll call vote of the Tribal Council.

CERTIFICATION
