ROSEBUD SIOUX TRIBE Resolution No. 2022-26

- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is a federally recognized Indian Tribe organized pursuant to the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 and all pertinent amendments thereof; and
- WHEREAS, the Rosebud Sioux Tribe is governed by a Tribal Council made up of elected representatives who act in accordance with the powers granted to it by its Constitution and By-Laws; and
- WHEREAS, One-time funding in the amount of \$50,000.00 has been allocated to the Rosebud Sioux Tribe's Tribal Historic Preservation and Cultural Resources Management program to assist in the documentation of cage locations across 40 Rosebud Sioux Tribe Range Units already identified in a grass survey project conducted by the Rosebud Sioux Tribes local Bureau of Indian Affairs; and
- WHEREAS, An employee of THP & CRM will use Drone Technology to document each location by video and digital image on all identified 40 Rosebud Sioux Tribe Range Units; and
- WHEREAS, An employee of THP & CRM will provide Rosebud Sioux Tribes local Bureau of Indian Affairs a completed organized video, digital images and/or power point to identify the grass utilization for the 2021 grazing season on the identified 40 Rosebud Sioux Tribe Range Units immediately upon completion; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rosebud Sioux Tribe approves the obligation of funds in the amount of \$50,000.00 for expenditures related to the documentation, mapping and media assistance for 40 identified Rosebud Sioux Tribe Range Units, now

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Tribal Council does direct the President or his designee of the Tribe to sign all documents and assurances in conjunction with these activities.

CERTIFICATION
